MGGEU is not only an educational, but also a scientific and research platform. Specialized scientific work related to the life of people with disabilities is being carried out here, there is a school of thought "Inclusive education and social integration of people with disabilities" and a scientific and educational center (NOC) which researches into the field of modern technologies that contribute to disabled people rehabilitation. At the Preparatory department of the University, young people improve their educational level and prepare for entering the University, mastering science and general educational disciplines; they also receive assistance in finding their professional identity.

MGGEU students with disabilities are guaranteed full-board accommodation, enhanced stipend and medical assistance. Students with musculoskeletal problems are provided with wheel-chairs, parking lots, wheelchair lifts, assistance handles, wheelchair ramps and adapted restrooms. The University sees its mission in fulfilling the intellectual and creative potential of each student through implementing innovative educational schemes which ensure maximum employment of students' capacities and inclinations. Training sessions are based on the use of advanced technologies and adapted educational techniques. The teaching policy includes individual approach to every student aimed at boosting their needs to integrate into the educational environment which will help them to adapt to their future professional activities and social involvement in general.

FACULTY OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES

The mission of the Faculty is to train professionals of a wide profile. Teaching is carried out with the use of the latest information and communication technologies and multimedia teaching aids.

Learned languages: English, Turkish, German, Spanish, French.

Faculty graduates are qualified linguists-translators with 2 working languages, specializing in enabling international communication. They work as translators in the field of interpretation and translation, translators-editors, translators-referees, analysts in information and analytical companies.

FACULTY OF ECONOMICS

The faculty trains bachelors in the following majors: Economics (skills profiles "World economy" and "Accounting, analysis and audit"); Management (skills profiles "Small business management" and "International management").

Graduates of the Faculty of Economics are competent leaders and leading experts on economic issues in state, regional, municipal government, in the budgetary sphere, institutional structures of the financial market, tax institutions, financial and economic, analytical, foreign economic divisions of enterprises and institutions.

FACULTY OF PEDAGOGY AND PSYCHOLOGY

The faculty trains professional psychologists (with skills profile "Psychology of development and education"), as well as educational psychologists for institutions of inclusive education (skills profile "Psychology and pedagogy of inclusive education") and institutions of special (correctional) education (skills profile "Special pedagogy and psychology"). These specialists are in demand in the labor market.

Graduates can be employed by educational organizations, commercial structures, psychological counseling services, state and municipal authorities.

The only faculty in the Russian Federation which trains persons with disabilities to be skilled specialists in the legal field. The faculty has favourable environment for training future experts and provides conditions for them to unlock their professional and creative potential. Modern information technologies and simulation computer programs are used in academic activities.

Our graduates can work for state and local authorities, justice institutions, internal affairs, customs authorities, in courts, notaries and the legal profession, enterprises and organizations providing legal services. Practice shows that most of the graduates of the faculty are successfully employed in central and local authorities, as well as in business structures.

FACULTY OF SOCIOLOGY AND JOURNALISM

The faculty trains journalists to work in the field of news journalism, online journalism, advertising business, organizing media projects, press studios, television and video filming; modern editorial specialists, as well as qualified practice-oriented sociologists with an in-depth knowledge of the social aspects of the functioning of markets.

Faculty graduates can work in publishing houses, libraries, instant printeries, news agencies, human resources offices as well as in the media, analytical agencies, political technology and marketing spheres and in the field of sociology, government authorities.
